
What do the work of artist Claudia Wieser and magician <u>Yves Saint Laurent</u> have in common? The love of forms, an artistic vision under the prism of geometry, a common conception that engages in a casual dialogue housed in the setting of the emblematic Parisian museum on avenue Marceau.

Resonance and modernity

The <u>Yves Saint Laurent Museum</u> begins a new artistic chapter, and invites **Claudia Wieser** to take over the space. His decorations and works intuitively echo some forty haute couture models, ready-to-wear, accessories and sketches from the Museum's collections.

The forms invented by <u>Yves Saint Laurent</u> are inspired by contemporary artistic trends, simple and geometric abstraction, constructivism and concrete art. The couturier dresses his pieces with abstract and colorful compositions, which sometimes oscillate between purity of lines and exuberance.

These concepts join those of **Claudia Wieser**, whose work is inspired by **Kandinsky** and **Paul Klee**. Thus, the geometric construction is the artistic link between these two characters with a marginal vision, and tells the modernity of one era in another.
